

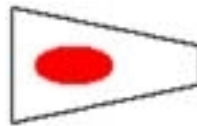
Racing – FPYC Summer 2008

Come out and race! If you are a FPYC member you can join us every Wednesday for fun Club Racing. If you want to crew come to the D Dock shelter before the race (before 6pm) to get “picked up”. If you need crew for your boat send us a quick email to info@fpyc.ca or see Dennis Angle. Look for information at www.fpyc.ca

The course will be a simple windward / leeward course just off of Fifty Point. Plan on leaving the dock around 6pm. Racers can monitor VHF channel 22 for on the water details.

STARTING SEQUENCE.

(5 MIN.TO START) - NUMBER 1 FLAG UP



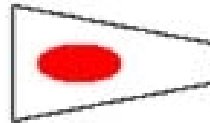
(4 MIN TO START) - P FLAG UP



(1 MIN TO START) - P FLAG DOWN

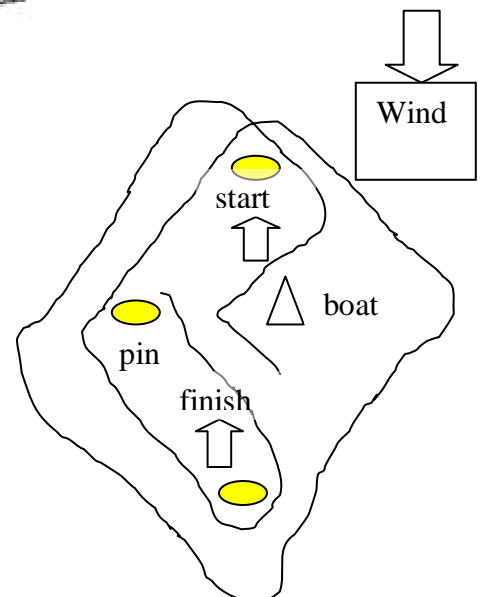


(START) - NUMBER 1 FLAG DOWN – HORN



The course will be two complete circles counter - clockwise.
Do not cross the start / finish line until you intend to finish.

If there is a second start the same sequence will have the Number 2 flag instead of the 1 flag. It looks like this:



Committee Boat notes

Plan to leave the dock around 6pm.

Turn the VHF on channel 22.

There will be 4 things anchored for the race.

- Committee Boat
- Pin
- Windward Mark
- Leeward Mark

These will roughly form a tall skinny diamond;

UP wind direction

W

Pin

CommBoat

L

The Windward and Leeward marks are yellow inflatable marks. The Pin is a yellow mark. The Committee boat and the pin will be anchored so that they are about 50 meters apart (half a football field) and so that the imaginary line between them is perpendicular to the wind direction.

This is the start / finish line.

The Windward mark will be ½ mile to windward of this line.

The leeward mark will be ½ mile to leeward of this line.

When possible two racing boats will drop the windward and leeward marks.

At 6:25 - start the sequence with the “One” flag.
