### Overview FPYC 2017 Annual General Meeting November 19 at the Ingledale House

The meeting started at 1:00 PM with opening remarks by the Commodore. These were followed by a marina update in which Rob Howe covered 2017 maintenance and improvement projects. We also had guests from the Conservation Foundation; Toby Tresidder and Margaret Reid provided information about the role of the Foundation and recent projects supported by their fundraising efforts. Toby pointed out that individuals or groups donating to the Foundation can direct the funds toward specific projects.

Membership, Social, Cruising and Communications Directors reported on 2017 activities. Garry Cooke provided information on racing opportunities for those who may be interested. We reviewed reciprocal activity for the season, followed by the Treasurer's report, the outlook for 2018 and changes to the Board of Directors.

The detailed slide deck will be posted in the members section of the FPYC website within the next few days and a reminder of the password for this section will be emailed to all members.

In summary: This has been an unusual year for FPYC, record high water levels in the first half of the season and heavy weather later in the summer resulted in the cancellation of a number of the club cruises. The early high water levels also resulted in a low number of reciprocal visitors.

Membership numbers and revenue were down from 2016 partly driven by a shift towards smaller vessels entering the marina.

Social events were generally well attended. The shift towards potluck and some very much appreciated event sponsorship reduced the overall costs and the effort needed for tickets sales. The exception was the Commodore's Ball, which was yet another great party but saw a drop in attendance.

Despite the reduced revenue from membership, the lower cost for reciprocals and reduction in some social event expenses enabled us to deliver a balanced budget for 2017.




