We are half way through the winter and getting ever closer to launch day!


First up is the Trivia night and the meeting of friends and getting back into the Marina life.

#### Lake Ontario HIGH WATER LEVELS

We have all been through the high waters off the 2017 and record breaking 2019 season and I have added a chart from the International Joint Commission (IJC) website on current water levels and predicted until June 2020. The IJC are charged with the control of "outflow" (water going out of Lake Ontario) and on the chart you can see the potential of high water in the spring is being predicted for a "wet" spring. If you look at the chart and compare back to the 2019 season we are in high water territory now in the winter, in fact if you look their website you will find Lake Ontario (and all the Great Lakes) are experiencing record or near record water levels for this time of year. Lake Ontario 6 inches higher than this time last year and is TWENTY inches higher than the long term (100year) average. This volume of water in the Upper Great Lakes will in a great part find its way down to Lake Ontario and we will get to deal with it for this year and into the next few by the statements of IJC, US Army Corp of Engineers and others.



YAY! It's finally March and soon we will be opening up our boats and getting ready for spring launch! In the meantime, here is a comfort food recipe to get you through the rest of the winter. I asked Dean what recipe he thought I should do for this month and he suggested one of his favourites..... we hope that you will enjoy.

#### **GOURMET MEATLOAF**

1 Tbsp olive oil; and a bit amore for the baking sheet

1/2 cup finely chopped onion

1-1/2 tsp. minced garlic

3/4 cup each of green, red and yellow pepper

3/4 lb. lean ground beef

3/4 lb. ground veal

3/4 lb. ground pork

1/2 cup tomato ketchup

1 Tbsp Dijon-style mustard

1-1/2 tsp. Worcestershire sauce

3/4 cup fresh plain breadcrumbs

1 egg

1/4 cup shredded basil

1/4 cup grated Parmesan cheese


1-1/2 tsp. salt

3/4 tsp. freshly ground black pepper

1 tbsp Italian seasoning

1/4 cup finely chopped fresh flat-leaf parsley

About 8 slices raw bacon



Pre-heat the oven to 350°F.

In a large mixing bowl, combine all the remaining ingredients except the bacon, and add the cooled pepperonion-garlic mixture. Mix with a rubber spatula or your hands, just until the ingredients are combined. Don't overwork the meat.

Oil a rimmed baking sheet or pan, turn the meat mixture out onto the pan, and shape it into a large loaf (I like mine to look like a slightly oval loaf of bread). Alternatively, you can divide the mixture into four equal portions (about 6 oz. each) and shape each portion into an individual meatloaf. Wrap strips of bacon around the shaped loaf, tucking the ends under the loaf.

Bake the meatloaf until an instant-read thermometer registers 160°F, about an hour for a large loaf, or 25 to 35 minutes for smaller loaves. Before slicing, let the meatloaf rest for 10 to 15 min. to allow some carryover cooking and to let the juices redistribute. To serve, slice into inch thick slices.
