## Christine's Galley

#### Amaretto Cheesecake



#### Graham Cracker Crust

1 1/2 cups graham cracker crumbs

1/4 cup brown sugar

1/2 cup butter melted

Combine together and press into 9" spring form pan, Bake 325 – 10 minutes, cook on wire rack

#### Cheesecake

Beat together until well blended:

2 cups cream cheese


1/2 cup sour cream

2/3 cup sugar

3 eggs – beaten 1 at a time

1 Tblsp almond extract

1 Tblsp amaretto



Bake @350 for 30-35 minutes (pan of water underneath in separate pan to prevent cracking)



#### **Topping**

Mix together and smooth over top after the 30 mins

- 1 cup sour cream
- 2 Tblsp sugar
- 2 Tblsp amaretto

Sprinkle 5 Tblsp toasted almonds over topping and return to oven for 5 minutes. Chill 3 – 4 hours

### Wind, Weather and Waves

#### Tornadoes, Waterspouts and Cold-air funnels

During periods of very cold, unsettled weather from mid- July to late October, cold-air funnels and waterspouts are possible with showers or small thundershowers over the lakes. On fair, cool days they can even occur with cumulus clouds over water. They are slender, smooth tubular extensions below a dark cloud base and they can reach down to the lake surface where some rising spray may be visible. The fully formed waterspout looks like a tornado but is not as dangerous. It is much smaller (7-20m diameter) and weaker (40-80kts wind vortex), and occurs in a non-severe weather situation. It is short lived and moves with the parent cloud.


They rarely do much damage, but can flip a boat if it makes direct contact – so avoid them whenever possible by moving away at right angles if they approach you. Watch the dark, straight base of cumulus or cumulonimbus near a shower to see if a bulge or a tuft appears. If it extends down or becomes a smooth point, it is a funnel which may become a waterspout. In most cases, waterspouts are first seen by the spray ring at the water's surface and not by a fully-formed funnel.

Tornadoes are rare over the Great Lakes but do occasionally occur with intense storms from May to September. Unlike waterspouts (which are a weak type of tornado), a regular tornado will be wider, more wedge-shaped, and will extend from a very low, dark cloud under a well-developed, large, fast-moving thunderstorm. Sometimes they are partly obscured by rain. The tornado usually forms over land and is carried over water when the storm moves offshore. Most severe storms are weakened by passing over the colder waters of the lakes, greatly reducing tornado potential over the water. At the very least, such storms can also have large hail, intense lightening, and violent squalls with it.


