Shrimp Salad on bread

16 oz of cooked, deveined small shrimp (I bought frozen and defrosted)
4 slices of canned pineapple, diced
1/2 cup mayo
1/4 cup ketchup
1 teaspoon curry

Directions:

Pat shrimp dry with paper towel
Dice shrimp and pineapple into small pieces (I left the shrimp whole)
Add mayo, ketchup and curry and stir gently to combine
Refrigerate for at least a couple of hours before serving
Serve on freshly baked bread (french stick) or crackers.




Boaters Tip of the Month
